



## THE FOLLOWING SAFETY RULES APPLY TO ALL RANGES

- No handling of Firearms when the Range is “COLD”.
- You may place your Cased Firearms at the Shooting Position and return to the Safe Area behind the Yellow Line when the Range is “COLD”.
- When the Range is “HOT” Eye and Ear Protection, at or near the Firing Line, is mandatory.
- Firearms may only be Loaded or Unloaded when the Range is “HOT”.
- No moving from one Shooting Lane to another without casing your Firearm.
- When the Range is “HOT” you may Uncase or Case Firearms at the Firing Line only, NOT ON THE BACK BENCH OR BEHIND THE FIRING LINE.
- Targets must be set at a height so that ALL BULLETS impact the Berm (on Range 5 use the chains anchored in the ground to ensure proper Target placement).
- Whether the Range Is “HOT” or “COLD”, all Muzzles MUST be pointed Downrange and level with the Berm (that is the ONLY Safe Direction).
- All shooting must be from the Marked Firing Line (no part off your body can be beyond this point when the Range is “HOT”).
- No Cross Lane or Cross Bay shooting (only fire at Targets in your lane / bay).
- Muzzle-loading Firearms MUST be loaded at the Firing Line ONLY when the Range is “HOT” (resting on or against the Shooting Bench with the muzzle pointed up and slightly forward). The Firearm must be placed on the bench, with the muzzle pointed Downrange and Level with the Berm before priming or capping.
- Read and Abide by the Rules posted at each Range.
- Note the location of the Air Horn, when it is to be used and the Procedures for notifying the Range Safety Officer in order to facilitate an Emergency Response.
- Note the location of the Trash and Brass containers, the location of Fan Switches, Firing Line, Safety Area, Back Bench, Safety Lights (Ranges 5 & 6) and overall Range Layout.
- When done shooting, clean your area, remove all of your Equipment, Trash and Brass.
