

## **ATTENTION: MCSA MEMBERS**

We would like to address questions we have been receiving regarding COVID-19 and how it may potentially impact Range Operations.

First and foremost, our top priority has always been the safety and well-being of the entire MCSA Community, their families and loved ones.

While the risk of infection remains lower in our area cases of Covid-19 continue to rise.

Until required to cease operations by an Executive Order from the Governor to Shelter in Place and Closure of all Non-Essential businesses, Martin County Sportsmen's Association plans on staying open for our members.

The impact this has had is unprecedented and we ask all members of the MCSA Community to be very conscious of and adhere to the CDC and Florida Governor Executive Orders of protecting yourself and others to stop the spread of this Virus.

- Clean your hands often with hand sanitizer especially after blowing your nose, coughing, sneezing or touching high touch surfaces. Bring Sanitizer, Disinfectant Wipes and or Gloves when you come to the Range.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with un-sanitized hands. We will be leaving the gate open and not requiring sign in upon arrival, therefore it is imperative you tell the RSO on duty which range(s) you will be shooting at.
- Avoid close contact with people and maintain social distancing; keep 6' distance between yourself and other people which is easy to do throughout our 7 firearms and archery Outdoor ranges.
- Avoid groups of 10 or more people; again, easy to do at MCSA.
- We respectfully request that you stay home if you are feeling sick, have a fever, coughing or sneezing.
