Membership Renewal

Membership Meeting is Coming up in March

The MCSA Annual Membership Meeting, Board of Directors Election and Picnic is scheduled for Sunday March 15, 2026. The Membership Meeting will begin at 10:00 a.m. The Board members will provide information about the Club, finances, growth, changes, etc. Any questions members may have will be answered. Prior to the 10:00 a.m. meeting, the club will be open at 8:00 a.m. for members to have a Swap Meet. Please remember that firearms (guns) are not allowed to be displayed in the Parking Lot (Photos are great though). Firearms can be inspected on Ranges 1 and 7 with all Safety Protocols enforced; transported from

vehicle in a case, uncased muzzle pointed downrange, inspected then re-cased and transported back to vehicle.

MCSA Range Safety

Once again, we have had several impacts toward the top of the Safety Baffle on Range 1. While all hits on the Baffles are an issue these were much too close to the top. We cannot have anything leave our range as it could jeopardize the existence of MCSA. To quote from the New Member Orientation Range Safety Booklet, “The purpose of the MCSA range safety rules is to promote safe and responsible gun handling and target shooting. Safety is the primary responsibility of every member using the range.” Here are two photos of the impacts:



We have installed impact sensors on several of the Safety Baffles which will cause a light to flash for a short period after impact. If you fire a shot and see the light flashing, please stop shooting and determine what mistake caused the strike. In addition, if you see the light flashing after someone else fires a shot, please

point this out to them. We have to stop the impacts on the Baffles. It needs to be noted that these impacts on the Range 1 Baffle are not the only impacts on the Baffles but are the most concerning.

Again, per the Orientation Booklet “In the event of any Negligent Discharge, and or Baffle Strikes, you must notify the RSO on duty” This is not to cause you any embarrassment we just need to make sure we know what caused each strike.

RANGE CLOSURES

There are a few range maintenance items planned which have not been scheduled yet which will require a Range or Ranges to be closed for a short time. Keep an eye out for the Eblast announcement once project has been scheduled.

NEW MEMBER ORIENTATION
