The BOD is happy to announce that the new Range 1 building has been dedicated to Dave. The Plaque shown below will be installed soon.

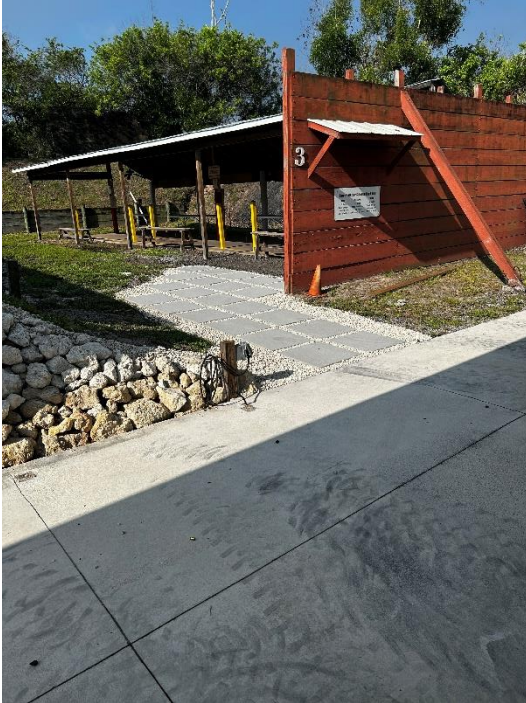


Opening on Board of Directors

Range Improvements

We have been experiencing erosion on the Range 3 berm which washes out to the Range 2 concrete pad. We have also experienced some flooding in front of the concrete pad on Range 5. Both of these problems have been addressed and thankfully we were able to get them corrected before rainy season kicks in.



All the target stands on Range 5 and Range 6 have been replaced with new stands that hold the stick in place with a wedge replacing the screws on the old stands which had rusted solid. We need to thank Carl Phair for building the new stands. In addition, when the new stands were placed, we need to thank David Fischer for ensuring they were set at a true 100 yards and 50 yards.

Guest Reminder

Members are 100% Responsible for Their Guest(s) and Must Directly Supervise them to ensure Adherence to All MCSA Safety Procedures, protocols, and SOP's. Only Members can move firearms to and from the

shooting position and take them in and out of the case. Only one person may shoot at a time. When the member is shooting, the guest cannot shoot and must stay with and near the Member. When the Guest is shooting the Member is right next to them on the Firing Line at all times Supervising, Coaching and Directing their Guest ensuring MCSA Safe Gun Handling Standards, Safety Protocols, and Range Rules.
